TICKSEED	COREOPSIS GRANDIFLORA	PERENIAL	YELLOW	FLOWERS	ALL BLOOMING SEASON	FRESH/FROZEN	GATHER IN THE WILD	STANDARD	NOT RELIABLY A PERENNIAL, BUT RESEEDS. PARTIAL SHADE, SANDY SOIL. CAN BE FOUND IN OPEN FIELDS
GOLDENROD	SOLIDAGO	PERENIAL	YELLOW	FLOWERS	ALL BLOOMING SEASON	FRESH PREFERRED / FROZEN	GATHER IN THE WILD	STANDARD	EASY, GROWS IN AVERAGE, DRY TO WELL-DRAINED SOIL IN FULL SUN. TOLERATES POOR, DRY SOILS, CLAY, AND DROUGHT. OVER 120 VARIETIES
MADDER	RUBIA TINCTORIUM	PERENIAL	REDS	ROOTS	AFTER 2 - 3 YEARS IN FALL OR SPRING	FRESH/DRIED	8 - 10 PLANTS, INVASIVE	CHOP OR GRIND UP ROOTS, MAINTAIN LOWER TEMP IN DYE POT. DO NOT BOIL.	START FROM SEED. SPREADS. USE ROOTS AFTER 2 YEARS. ABOUT 3 FOOT TALL. FULL SUN. COLOR ATTAINED DEPENDS ON MINERAL CONTENT OF WATER AND SOIL USED. ALKALINE SOIL PRODUCES DEEPER COLOR.

YARROW	ACHILLEA MILLEFOLIUM	PERENIAL	YELLOW	WHOLE PLANT ABOVE GROUND	ANYTIME DURING BLOOMING SEASON	FRESH/FROZEN	FILL POT, 5 PLANTS PLUS	CHOP UP PLANT MATERIAL	FULL SUN, OFTEN PROPAGATED BY DIVISION. EASY TO GROW.
ZINNIA	ZINNIA ELEGANS	ANNUAL	YELLOW, RUST (ALL COLOR BLOOMS)	FLOWER, YELLOW AND WHITE HAVE LESS COLOR, (DYE)	ALL BLOOMING SEASON	FRESH PREFERRED/FROZEN	6 TO 10 PLANTS HARVESTED ALL BLOOMING SEASON	STANDARD	FULL SUN. MANY SIZES. SMALLER VARIETIES GROW WELL IN VEGETABLE GARDENS UNDER CUCUMBERS. PEPPERS AND TOMATOES. BENEFITS FROM DEAD HEADING.
