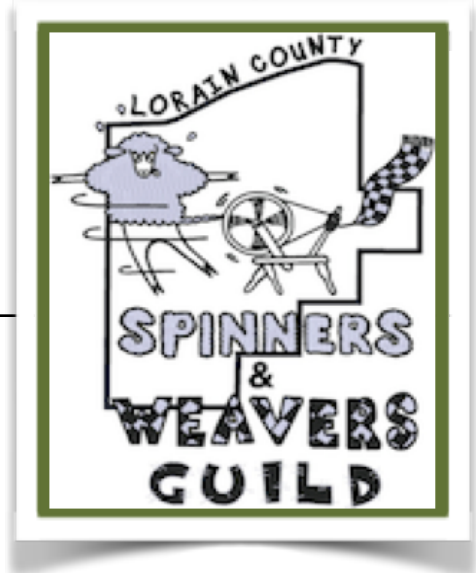

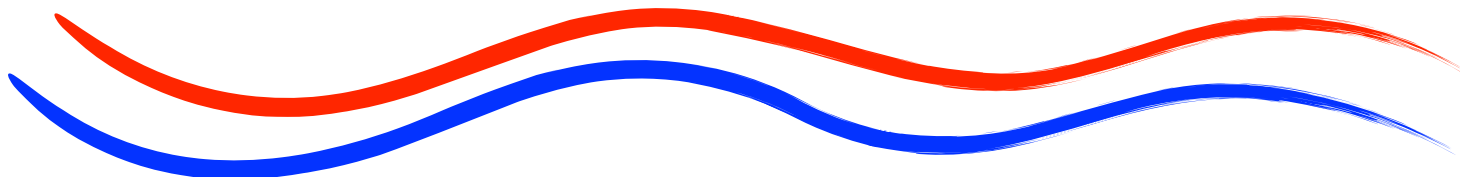


Happenings:
