

LOCO 2020 - 2021 Challenge Chain Reaction Collaboration

A chain reaction is a sequence of events where one event leads to another. LOCO Spinners and Weavers challenge this year is a sequence of finished projects.

One inspiration leads to another. But, it's a secret.

Five members will be grouped together to form a chain. The first member will create a project based on a <u>secret</u> inspirational photo. The project will be passed to member number two as inspiration to create his/her own project. Members three, four and five will receive a project in the same fashion. Member number five will eventually share with member one. (NOTE: Keep the project you received and bring it to the May, 2021 Pot Luck Dinner.) Keep your project a secret. Only the person receiving your project in the chain will see it. Don't share at show and tell.

Projects can be anything that inspires you; woven, spun, knitted, crocheted, beaded, felted, quilted or other crafted item.

Each member will have three months to create a project inspired by the piece received.

LOCO's challenge will start in February and end in May of 2021. All five projects will be brought to our May 2021 Potluck Dinner.
