You must purchase a \$30 membership pass to enter as many projects as you wish. \$30 Season pass will get you voting rights. The pass will get you seven tickets into the fair.

Entry errors will not be changed after July 31st. If fair makes error, it can be changed before August 12th.

You can find the fair book on line. Forms will be available July 1st online. Online will cost you \$4 more. Mailing in form will cost \$4 more. Taking it to the fair office will not add a fee to registration.

July 1st entries are accepted. August 5th is the deadline. If you are mailing your entry, it must reach the fair office by August 5th. Mail it early.
