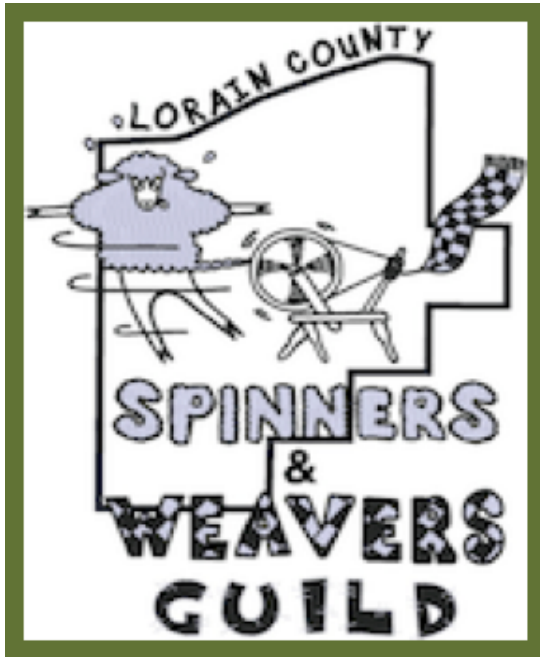

Jean O: Handmade bobbins, twill gamp



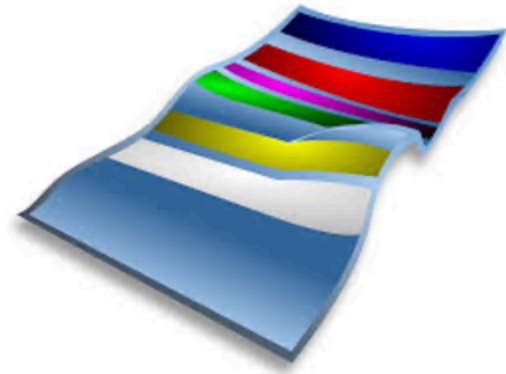
